



I'm not good at drawing - can I still study Animation?

Yes. We offer multiple pathways into the course regardless of your current drawing abilities and art is one of these pathways. If you don't feel all too comfortable drawing, we offer pathways in technical and conceptual skills.

Do I need to bring in a portfolio to support my application for the Animation course, and if so, what should I put in it?

A portfolio essentially relates to samples of your work. If you have nice finished artwork, that's fantastic, but not essential. What we're looking for is that you have a drive to create things and are passionate about the field, so show us that in your portfolio. Things like sketches or drawings, notes, ideas and characters you've invented are all great.

Is a JMC Academy degree of equal standing/value to a university degree?

Yes. The JMC Academy is registered and regulated by the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA) which is Australia's independent national regulator of the higher education sector, both public and private. What projects will I create during the Animation course that I can show future employers?

In the course of completing the Bachelor degree you will complete multiple key creative projects, both solo and in teams, as well as a host of smaller exercises. You will build your portfolio with polished work from your second trimester onwards and your last two trimesters will be devoted to a major project that will showcase your talent and abilities.

Are JMC courses available to study online?

No, our courses are hands on and practical. Students are required to attend classes to receive ongoing mentorship, learn new skills and work with the equipment provided. We do encourage our students to use online study resources, and we are providing various online support and learning material that will form an important part of your study. However, our courses would not be as immersive as they are without the practical component.

To enroll in this course, you will need to pay an enrolment fee, your first trimester/semester tuition fee and Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).

We offer a range of partial scholarships to eligible Bachelor and Master degree students as part of the JMC Student Ambassador program. Candidates must meet the normal entry requirements for international students, including course specific requirements.
